### Total incidents reported: Ashurst – 14 of which 2 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 25 of which 7 were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

**Anti-social behaviour** – Ashurst (0) Lyndhurst (1) A male in drink, attended a premises where he banged on the door police attended and removed male.

**Assaults** – Ashurst (0). Lyndhurst (1) there was one assault of domestic nature

**Road traffic collisions** – Ashurst (0) Lyndhurst (7) One involved minor injuries

**Road traffic incidents** – Ashurst (0) Lyndhurst (3) Three people were summonsed for speeding offences. A male was reported for driving in an ant-social manner in Lyndhurst car park. His vehicle was seized under a section 59

**Theft** – Amherst (1). Copper cable stolen from a telegraph pole. Lyndhurst (6) Half a drum of cooking oil stolen from the back of a restaurant

**Theft from vehicles** – Ashurst (0). Lyndhurst (3) All occurred in forest car parks. *Please ensure you continue to secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

**Other incidents** – 7 suspicious incidents –one of which a male was seen to be looking at cycles attached to a car parked in Lyndhurst car park.
