Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Our current priorities are tackling crime and Anti-social behaviour

Total incidents reported: Ashurst & Netley Marsh – 31 of which 10 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 37 of which 10 were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages and other non-crime matters.

Anti-social behaviour – A & NM (1) A resident received nuisance phone calls. Lyndhurst (6) There were two vehicle nuisance reports, two matters relating to nuisance communications and two people reported to be acting in an anti-social manner.

Assaults – A & NM (1) A incident occurred at a care home. Lyndhurst (1) There was an incident at a local home.

Burglary – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (0) *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

Burglary (non dwelling) – A & NM (2) Two outbuildings were broken into on the same farm in Woodlands (different owners). Lyndhurst (0) *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

Criminal Damage – A & NM (1) A car window was damaged in Woodlands. Lyndhurst (3) A vehicle was damaged in a Forest car park, an intercom system was damaged outside a B&B and damage was caused to a police vehicle.

Public Order – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (1) There was a dispute between two adults.

Road traffic collisions – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (2) Both resulted in minor injuries and one involved a cow.

Road traffic incidents – A & NM (1) A driver was summonsed for a speeding offence. Lyndhurst (4) Four drivers were summonsed for speeding offences.

Theft – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (2) There were two thefts at local businesses.

Theft from vehicles – A & NM (3) Items were stolen from three vehicles. Lyndhurst (0) *Please ensure you continue to secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

Speed watch – Please contact us if you would like further details of the recorded data and the action taken by police. Thank you to all involved in helping to make our villages safer. Please contact us if you would like details of how to volunteer.

The Constabulary is undergoing major changes over the next few months and this includes the way we share information.
