Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Targeting crime and Anti-Social behaviour

Total incidents reported: Ashurst - 15 of which 7 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 26 of which 9 were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

Anti-social behaviour – Ashurst (1) A parking complaint. Lyndhurst (1) People were heard to be smashing glass in the Lyndhurst car park.

Assaults – Ashurst (1) This took place at a local hospital. Lyndhurst (3) An altercation took place at a local pub and in a separate incident a police officer was assaulted.

Burglary – Lyndhurst (1) An attempt was made to gain entry to a front door of a property on the Southampton road. *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

Burglary (non dwelling) – Lyndhurst (2) Two males were arrested following a theft from a hotel kitchen in Lyndhurst. Another local hotel had items stolen from a storage shed. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

Criminal Damage – Ashurst (1) a driver's side window of a car had been smashed while parked outside a residential property. Lyndhurst (1) A group in fancy dress were seen damaging property at Goose green.

Drugs – Ashurst (1) - A males was found to be in possession of Class C drug.

Public Order – (0)

Road traffic collisions – Ashurst (1) New road. Lyndhurst (3) A337, Clayhill, Lyndhurst High Street.

Road traffic incidents – Ashurst (2) Two drivers were reported for speeding on Lyndhurst Rd. Lyndhurst (1) A male reported for speeding on the Southampton Rd.

Theft – Ashurst (1) Items were stolen from a convenience store. Lyndhurst (1) Unknown persons stole a mobile phone from a customer in a coffee shop.

Theft from vehicles – (3) All involving unattended vehicles being broken into in Forest car parks *Please ensure you secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

Other incidents – A number of suspicious vehicles and people have been reported in the last month. *Please continue to be vigilant and report these incidents.*
