### Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Our current priorities are tackling crime and Anti-social behaviour

**Total incidents reported: Ashurst & Netley Marsh – 25 of which 3 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 50 of which 11 were crimes**

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

**Anti-social behaviour** – A & NM (3) There was a report of a moped causing a nuisance, a noise complaint and a neighbour dispute. Lyndhurst (5) There were four noise complaints and a report of motorcycle nuisance.

**Assaults** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (2) There were two allegations of assault.

**Burglary** – A & NM (1) There was a burglary in Woodlands. Lyndhurst (0). *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

**Burglary (non dwelling)** – A & NM (0). Lyndhurst (2) There were two reports at an commercial premise. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

**Criminal Damage** – A & NM (1) A window was damaged at a dwelling in Ashurst Bridge. Lyndhurst (1) Property was damaged at a local school.

**Drugs** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (0)

**Public Order** – A & NM (1) There was a report of rude door to door seller in Woodlands. Lyndhurst (1) There was a report of a dispute following a driving complaint.

**Road traffic collisions** – A & NM (2) There were collisions in Netley Marsh and on Lyndhurst road; there were no injuries. Lyndhurst (3) No persons were injured.

**Road traffic incidents** – A & NM (1) A vehicle was seized for document offences. Lyndhurst (3) Three people were summonsed for speeding offences and an uninsured vehicle was seized.

**Theft** – A & NM (0). Lyndhurst (1) A flag was stolen from outside a shop on the High Street.

**Theft from vehicles** – A & NM (1) Items were stolen from a vehicle in Ashurst Bridge. Lyndhurst (3) Three vehicles were broken in to in Forest car parks. *Please ensure you continue to secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*
