Following the Planning Committee Meeting on 20th October the committee would like to recommend REFUSAL, for the reasons listed below;

In accordance with DP1 a, The proposals are out of character with the surrounding houses and area, in terms of size and design of the proposed property and also would have a negative impact on the amenity of the neighbours in terms the size and scale of the property causing overlooking, visual intrusion and shadowing issues (dp1, d) and consequently there are objections to the plans from the immediate neighbours.

The committee also feel that the size and scale of the proposals do not enhance the immediate surrounding natural and built environment (DP1, b, DP9) which is characterised by large houses in large plots and that this development would not be in keeping with that. Also that the proposed materials are not in keeping with surrounding properties, which are all brick built.

The committee would also like to draw attention to the plan to leave the stables in situ, a building which is not considered to be small, but to build the house on the adjoining paddock, thus rendering the stables redundant and resulting in a loss of open space.
