### Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Our current priorities are tackling crime and Anti-social behaviour

**Total incidents reported: Ashurst & Netley Marsh – 22 of which 7 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 46 of which 19 were crimes**

The other reported incidents related to information messages and other non-crime matters.

**Anti-social behaviour** – A & NM (4) There were reports of noisy fireworks, nuisance motorcycles, and two of nuisance youths. Lyndhurst (1) There was a report of a nuisance vehicles.

**Assaults** – A & NM (2) Both occurred at care homes. Lyndhurst (1) There was an incident that was domestic related.

**Burglary** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (1) An address was broken into near to the High Street. *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

**Burglary (non dwelling)** – A & NM (1) A commercial premise was broken into. Lyndhurst (1) A door was forced to a premise on the High Street but nothing was taken. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

**Criminal Damage** – A & NM (1) An underpass wall was damaged. Lyndhurst (5) There was damage caused to a hotel window, a forest marker post, a communal door, a security light and a lorry.

**Drugs** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (1) A local female was found in possession of a class B drug.

**Public Order** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (1) There was a domestic incident where threats were made.

**Road traffic collisions** – A & NM (1) A passenger suffered minor injuries. Lyndhurst (4) Three involved animals, no persons were injured.

**Road traffic incidents** – A & NM (1) A driver was summonsed for a speeding offence. Lyndhurst (1) A driver was summonsed for a speeding offence.

**Theft** – A & NM (1) Building materials were stolen. Lyndhurst (2) Items were stolen from a restaurant and a building site.

**Theft from vehicles** – A & NM (0). Lyndhurst (5) All were broken in to in local car parks. *Please ensure you continue to secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

**Speed watch** – A total of 2990 vehicles were checked by Speed watch volunteers in October/November. Of those, 1490 (49.8%) motorists were recorded exceeding the speed limit.
