### Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Our current priorities are tackling crime and Anti-social behaviour

**Total incidents reported: Ashurst & Netley Marsh – 22 of which 6 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 66 of which 20 were crimes**

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

**Anti-social behaviour** – A & NM (4) There was a parking complaint and three noise complaints. Lyndhurst (13) There were four noise complaints and four reports of inconsiderate behaviour.

**Assaults** – A & NM (2) One was domestic related. Lyndhurst (2) One occurred at a local school and one was domestic related.

**Burglary** – A & NM (0). Lyndhurst (3) There were three dwelling burglaries in the village; investigations are ongoing. *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

**Burglary (non dwelling)** – A & NM (0). Lyndhurst (2) There were two reports at commercial premise. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

**Criminal Damage** – A & NM (1) This occurred at a commercial premise. Lyndhurst (3) Three vehicles were damaged along with a boundary fence.

**Drugs** – A & NM ( ) Lyndhurst (2) Two people were found in possession of illicit drugs.

**Public Order** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (0)

**Road traffic collisions** – A & NM (2) No persons were injured. Lyndhurst (7) No persons were injured.

**Road traffic incidents** – A & NM (0) Lyndhurst (3) Three people were summonsed for speeding offences.

**Theft** – A & NM (1) There was an isolated incident at a convenience store. Lyndhurst (6) There were six thefts from commercial premise.

**Theft from vehicles** – A & NM (1) A spare wheels was stolen from a vehicle parked in Netley Marsh. Lyndhurst (1) A vehicle was broken in to in a Forest car park. *Please ensure you continue to secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

**Other incidents** – Between 1<sup>st</sup> November 2013 and 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014 1718 drivers have been dealt with for speeding offence on the beat. From today you can access up to date data. **Speed watch** – A total of 2249 vehicles were checked by Speed watch volunteers in July. Of those, 1236 (54.9%) motorists were recorded exceeding the speed limit.
