**PROPOSAL:** Single storey rear extension

Recommend; Option 1 PERMISSION, but would accept the decision reached by the National Park Authority's Officers under their delegated powers.

The proposals would have no impact on either the street scene, or neighbouring amenity and there were no issues identified within policies CP11 or DP8.

**PROPOSAL:** Two storey rear extension

Recommend; Option 5, to accept the decision reached by the National Park Authority's Officers under their delegated powers.

Concerns were raised regarding both the design and the size and bulk of the proposals in relation to the existing dwelling. The extension did not appear subservient in accordance with policy DP1 and DP11. In addition to this the design was not in keeping with the current property and did not enhance it (DP1 and 6). The committee noted that similar dwellings in Whartons Lane had undergone similar extensions and cited the proposals / development at 55 Whartons Lane as an ideal example.
