	Recommend Option 3, Refusal. It was noted that the plans did not differ much from the original application. The proposals were overbearing on neighbouring properties and that the building did not appear incidental to the main dwelling (DP12). The cladding proposed was not in keeping with the existing property or with the area and there were concerns regarding massing and over development of the plot, given the other outbuildings already within the curtilage of the dwelling.			
	19/00361	12 Foxhills	New front porch	
	Recommend Permission but would accept the decision reached by the National Park Authority's Officers under their delegated powers. The Committee felt that the proposals were in keeping with the existing dwelling. It was agreed, in accordance with the officer's first thoughts, that due to the openness of the porch it would not represent an increase in the floorspace of the dwelling.			
PD/19/009	Fawley Power Station. To consider a response to the recent planning application. Concerns were raised regarding the impact of traffic on local roads in the parish and the possibility of negating some of the impact with the implementation of more sustainable methods of travel, e.g. trains, buses, ferries, cycles. The impact of the development on the open forest was also raised, with concerns being aired that both the numbers of vehicles, size of vehicles and the pollution of same would have a detrimental impact on the forest			
	flora and fauna and surrounding areas. It was noted that the committee would like to see a comprehensive traffic review undertaken by HCC. The committee responded positively to the principle of development.			
	It was agreed that the clerk should write a response, based on the points raised in the meeting, to be sent to both NFDC and NFNPA and would circulate to councillors for comments before sending.
