Councillor Hubbard advised Members that she had received an email from a resident regarding the works going on at 58 Woodlands Road. The resident explained that they had been walking down Woodlands Road and looked over the fence at the works going on. A man who said he was the owner was very aggressive towards the resident and said that they shouldn't be on the verge as he had purchased this as well. The man's wife then was verbally abusive to the resident. The Parish Council has previously contacted the enforcement department at NFNPA to report that several residents had contacted us over the works and that they didn't seem to be carried out as per the planning permission. The Parish Clerk has received a letter from the Enforcement Officer to say that they were happy that there has been no breach. The matter was discussed by all Councillors and it was <a href="#">AGREED:</a> that Councillor Hubbard will reply to the resident and ask them to make PCSO Williams aware of the abuse from the alleged owner of 58 Woodlands Road. Councillor Robinson will write to the Enforcement Officer to make them aware and also ask how this isn't a breach, when the original planning permission was to amend an original house, not demolish it and re-build it.
